This has reference to your application for an IASc-INSA-NASI Focus Areas in Science and Technology Fellowship - Maths, Arts and Design summer school. We are happy to offer you a Fellowship to participate in this school for one month during June 11 to July 10 2018 subject to verification of your marks as stated by you in the application with the marks sheets.

The school will be held at Indian Academy of Sciences, Bengaluru for most of the period. Apart from this ICTS & Gyanome will arrange visits to their campuses. The full details of syllabus etc will be made available by June 10.

This Fellowship is subject to the following norms:

- The duration of the Fellowship is four weeks 11 June to 10 July 2018 including Sundays and General Holidays), and is not to be reduced. If you do not complete this requirement, you will not be paid the fellowship and the certificate that is usually issued on completion. However, if this period is not suitable you may mention other possible periods. We may consider alternate periods subject to availability of mentors and the convenience of the organizers.
- You will be provided a second class [sleeper] train fare from your place of stay to Bengaluru and back.
- You will be paid a Fellowship of Rs. 10,000/- towards your boarding, lodging and local transport expenses. Those who are in receipt of INSPIRE/KVPY Fellowship will be covered by a separate arrangement, the details of which will be communicated later.
- The Academy will arrange accommodation at subsidized rates, the cost of which should be borne by you. Full details will be provided to you by 10 June.


Please also go through carefully & comply with all the Instructions given in the attached sheet.
