Introductory Remarks:

Principal Dr.K.R.Viswanathan briefly explained the successful completion of academic programme for the First Year autonomous batch students during 2012 – 13. The conduct of end semester examinations, declaration of results and award of grade sheets were highlighted. Then the agenda for the meeting was tabled and following items were discussed:

Item No.1

Compliance of previous resolutions:

The resolutions of the previous meeting were read out. It was explained to the board that all the resolutions were carried out meticulously. After few clarifications the board acknowledged its appreciation and wanted sustained growth.

Item No.2

Fee revision, remuneration recommended by the finance committee:

The member secretary narrated the necessity for the fee revision of end semester UG/PG examinations consequent to persistent proposal for generous revision of

remuneration for the question paper setting, central valuation and other associated expenses.

The recommended fee, remuneration revision by the finance committee was spelt out for the board's approval. Dr.Silas Sargunam sought clarifications as to the guidelines for arriving at the revised fee, remuneration structure. It was clarified by the Controller of Examination office that fee revision is as per the norms of the nearest autonomous Government Institutions, Alagappa Chettiar College of Engineering and Technology, Karaikudi.

Resolution:

It was resolved, after the consent of university nominee, to approve the revised fee, remuneration structure and to effect the same from the academic year 2013 – 14 onwards.

Item No.3:

Resolutions of Academic Council:

Principal while explaining the resolutions of second academic council highlighted the academic audit proposed by Dr.S.Thamaraiselvi, Dean, MIT, Chennai and emphasized by the other members.

As per the suggestions by the academic council Regional Director, Anna University Tirunelveli Region was contacted for the academic audit and it was carried out by a team of experts with Regional Director as the convenor on 31.08.2013. Dr.Silas Sargunam wanted to know the exact process of academic audit.

Resolution:

With an appreciation by university nominee and subsequent discussion it was resolved that heads of department and all the faculty members shall extend their fullest co-operation in discharging the responsibilities.

Item No.4:

Promotion of research activities:

Citing the availability of faculty members with Ph.D qualifications in all the departments and more number of staff members pursuing Ph.D programme, Principal

stressed the importance of promoting research activities by all the departments and invited proposal and suggestions from the members.

Principal proposed that all the departments shall take steps to get approval from University as research centre. During discussion it was suggested to University nominee for getting approval for a common research centre for Tirunelveli region as done by the erst while Anna University of Technology, Tirunelveli.

Director R.Sundar wanted all the departments to prepare and send proposal, to various organizations for funded research projects.

Creation of corpus fund for access to online research journals was suggested by the management. The following resolutions were arrived:

- Resolved to address the Director, Centre for Research for common research facility at Tirunelveli region with a copy marked to Registrar, Director (Research) Tirunelveli.
- Resolved to subscribe for ejournals for all disciplines to promote research activities and to receive nominal subscriptions from the research scholars.
- Resolved to fix target for the international journal publication, Accordingly faculty members with Ph.D qualifications shall send atleast 2 research papers and the candidates pursuing Ph.D shall send atleast one paper per semester.
- Resolved to send proposals for funded research project by each department.

Item No.5:

Accreditation:

Discussions on NBA reaccreditation for CSE, ECE, IT, EEE and new accreditation for MECH were taken up. Few members suggested for NAAC accreditation.

Resolved that all the departments shall set vision and mission and proceed to apply for either NBA or NAAC as may be decided later at an appropriate time.



Item No.6:

Vision and Mission of the Institute:

Principal informed the members that a committee constituted by the Principal has drafted Vision and Mission for the College considering the expectations /suggestion of various stakeholders and invited their feedback and suggestions to finalize the same. After discussion the members resolved to ratify the Vision and Mission of the Institute as follows:

Vision: To contribute to the society through excellence in technical education with societal values and thus a valuable resource for industry and the humanity.

Mission:

- To create an ambience for quality learning experience by providing sustained care and facilities.
- To offer higher level training encompassing both theory and practices with human and social values.
- To provide knowledge based services and professional skills to adapt tomorrow's technology and embedded global changes.

Item No.7:

Any other matters:

Placement:

Principal requested that all the heads of the department shall closely monitor the placement programme implemented by the management for all the final years.

Resolved to see that all final year students are properly trained to face the placement process successfully. It was further resolved to address the Regional Director, requesting for few exclusive combined placement drives for Tirunelveli region.

Buildings:

Management was requested to construct an exclusive autonomous block housing facilities like exam hall, exam office, conference hall, valuation centre etc. Management was further requested to consider extension of existing Electrical and Electronics Engineering block.

Resolution:

Management agreed to consider the building proposals favorably and to implement at an



appropriate time.

Sports activities:

While appreciating the encouragement by the management in promoting sports and games activities, a request was made to carry out relaying of wooden floor of the indoor stadium and to add two more gym equipments. Management accepted the request favorably for taking necessary steps.

Local needs:

The suggestion by State Government nominee to create facility to address the issues related to local fireworks and printing industries and to offer feasible solutions, was taken up for discussion.

It was discussed and resolved to receive issues and challenges related to safety and environmental issues of fireworks industries through our management and to provide solutions through our research resources of physics and chemistry.

Teaching methodologies:


Dean wanted to adopt new teaching methodologies using teaching aids.

Resolved to install permanently LCD projector for each PG class room.

Communication skills:



2. CODE OF CONDUCT

Leave letter and medical certificate submitted at a later date will not be accepted.*

7. LIBRARY

The institution has a computerised library in a separate two storeyed building with a built up area of 2,000 sq.m. Library is kept open on all working days from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. and 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on holidays. The library has a collection of 35,000 volumes. In addition to this, number of journals, periodicals, technical magazines and e-journals are also available for reference. On-line reference facility for journals is also available.

Students, Faculty, staff, authorities of the institute and guest visitors (with the permission of the principal or the librarian) are eligible to use the facility of library.

Reference materials, books, current periodicals and bound & loose back volumes etc. can be referred to in the library. Books which are kept under special category will be issued on requisition. Taking clippings of advertisements, removal of plates or diagrams and any other form of mutilation are strictly forbidden. If any thing of this nature is observed, severe disciplinary action will be taken and they will not be permitted to utilise the library facilities further.

BORROWING

a. Materials :

All materials, except reference books, are issued to the members. Materials considered as reference books are encyclopedia, dictionaries, handbooks, periodicals (bound and loose), and books which are in great demand.

b. Conditions of Borrowing :

Students are permitted to borrow 4 books at a time from the Library. Books borrowed should be returned on or before the due date. If a book is not returned on the due date, an overdue charge of rupee one per volume per day shall be levied.

If a book is due for over a month, a notice for its return with overdue charges will be put up in the college notice board. If the book is not returned within seven days after the date of notice, steps will be taken to recover the cost of books plus overdue charges.

c. Teaching Staff :

Each staff can take six library books at a time. Normally the period of loan will be for three months. However the period of loan can be extended if the books taken by them are not demanded by the other members of faculty or students.

d. Non-Teaching Staff :

Each member of non teaching staff is eligible for two library books. The period of loan is one month. Periodicals will not be issued on any account.

GENERAL RULES

- ☉ *Personal belongings should be left in the property counter at the entrance of the library. However, no valuable things must be left in the property counter. Library staff shall not be responsible for any loss of valuables.*

- ☉ *All library users are required to enter in the e-Gate kept at the entrance every time they enter into the library.*
- ☉ *The library follows open access system. Hence, books taken out of the racks should not be replaced after reference by the users. They should be left on the table itself and the library staff would place them back on the racks.*
- ☉ *A book misplaced is a book lost forever. Replacing books on different locations in the rack should be avoided. Such activities are considered as serious offence. Anybody intentionally doing this would be severely punished.*
- ☉ *Personal books, library books already issued, notebooks etc. should not be taken inside the library. Only loose sheets are allowed inside.*
- ☉ *Strict silence should be observed inside the library.*
- ☉ *Books will be lent to the students only upon producing the identity card.*
- ☉ *Members are responsible for the books borrowed. Any damage to the books or unwanted marking or scribbling found in the book will attract severe penalty or replacement of the book by the borrower.*

LOSS OF BOOKS

- ☉ *Any book that is lost by the borrower must be brought to the notice of the librarian immediately.*
- ☉ *The borrower is liable to replace the books that are lost or damaged. If unable to replace the book lost, recovery of cost of the book will be made as per the rules and regulations in force from time to time.*
- ☉ *Borrowers should surrender all the books and settle down all overdue charges, if any, at the time of request for 'No dues' certificate from the library.*

8. FACILITIES

COMPUTER

All the departments have well equipped computer laboratories as per the curriculum requirement of the Anna University. Modern computing facilities are available in various departments of the institution. High speed Internet Connectivity with 22 Mbps is available. Students are free to access the computing facility and internet facility even beyond the office hours. The computer centres are normally kept open till 7.00 p.m. on all working days and from 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on holidays.

COUNSELLING SYSTEM

20 students are assigned to a faculty member, called faculty advisor who will be available for consultation and advice on all matters, for the betterment of students in their studies. Faculty advisor - ward meetings are held regularly. Students are expected to meet the assigned faculty advisors and discuss the problems and progress in study and also other relevant matters. All the leave letters and other correspondence to the principal should be forwarded through the faculty advisors and respective HODs.

MEDICAL FACILITY

A medical practitioner in the cadre of Civil Surgeon visits the institution periodically and takes care of the medical needs of the students. A paramedical staff is available for providing first aid to students and staff inside the campus.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Facilities are available for playing the following games in the campus : cricket, foot ball, volley ball, hockey, tennis, tennycourt, etc. A fully furnished indoor stadium along with a multi gym has been constructed to meet the needs of the students in sports and games. Students are encouraged to participate in inter collegiate, state level and national level sports meet.

EDUCATION SYSTEM

The college follows continuous and comprehensive assessment system. Every day morning first hour (alternate weeks) a test will be conducted in all the subjects. In addition to the above, two internal assessment tests are conducted. Equal weightage is given for all the test performance, while awarding the internal assessment marks. pre semester examination following end semester exam pattern is conducted at the end of the semester to train the students to face end semester examination confidently.

CLUBS / ASSOCIATIONS

The inherent talent of the students in various cocurricular activities are brought to lime light through their participation in the following clubs of the institute. I) Nature Club, ii) Quiz Club, iii) Fine arts Club, iv) Sports Club

This will help the students to take up constructive challenges in their future career. Students of all disciplines are benefitted through this laboratory.

9. HOSTELS

Separate hostels for boys and girls are available in the campus. The boys hostel (I & II) can accommodate 600 students and the girls hostel (I & II) can accommodate 700 students. The rooms are spacious and airy. These hostels also have facilities for indoor games in addition to reading room, audio visual room, sick room and visitor's room. Resident warden residing in the girls hostel takes care of the girl students.

MANAGEMENT OF THE HOSTEL

The general administration of the hostel is vested with the head of institution who is also the chief warden. He is assisted by deputy wardens and residential tutors. The deputy warden and residential tutors look after the day to day administration of the hostel.

HOSTEL COMMITTEE

The hostel committee will be constituted at the beginning of every year. The committee consists of the following members.

Chief Warden, Deputy Warden, Residential Tutors and Representatives of the students.

MESS AND MESS RULES

The hostel has both vegetarian and non-vegetarian mess. Every inmate of the hostel has to dine compulsorily in one of the two messes. The menu served shall be prepared and approved by the hostel committee.

ENTERTAINMENT OF GUESTS

- ☉ Members are permitted to entertain guests to a limited number in each mess. The inmates entertaining the guests should make entry in the guest book in his / her own handwriting, get duly filled in counterfoil and take the guests inside the dining hall. The guests should always be accompanied by the host.
- ☉ Hostellers are not permitted to entertain the day scholar students as guests under any circumstance.

DISCIPLINE

Every inmate of the hostel is expected to maintain a high standard of discipline. Inmates should refrain from antisocial activities like consuming alcoholic beverage, intoxicating drug etc.. Possession of mobile phones, banned electronic gadgets, usage of laptops without permission are all prohibited inside the hostel.

Indulgence in serious offences mentioned above will result in their expulsion from the hostel. The chief warden, deputy warden and residential tutors shall decide on the course of disciplinary action against students involved in such offences. A student once expelled from the hostel will not be eligible for readmission. No inmate is allowed to entertain any expelled student in the hostel.

HOSTEL PROPERTY

Members are personally responsible for the electrical fittings in their rooms and for the maintenance of the furniture and return of the furniture allotted to them in proper condition. In case of any damage caused to the hostel property, the charges will be recovered from the students.

MEDICAL FACILITIES

The hostel has a dispensary. The medical officer of the institution visits the hostel periodically. A nurse is present all the time at ladies hostel to attend to medical needs.

ACCOMMODATION FOR GUESTS

No guest shall be permitted to stay in the hostel. However, guests with valid reasons, desirous of staying should obtain prior permission from the deputy warden. A separate register for guests is maintained in the hostel office. Proper entries should be made in the register before taking a guest to the room for their stay.

MINERAL WATER PLANT

Mineral water plants at different locations have been installed in the campus. They cater to the needs of all students and staff in the campus.

PHONE FACILITIES

BSNL coin box phones with recharge card facility are available in both boys and girls hostels. Students are allowed to utilize the facility except during study hours.

Students can receive phone calls from their parents between 5.00 p.m. to 8.00 p.m.
